



## BEDBUG TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

### PREPARATION

- Vacuum all carpets and beds. Empty the vacuum into a bag outside, then place the bag in the outside trash can
- Take all the clothes out of dressers and closets and place them in black trash bags. Place the trash bags out in the sun in the backyard. They must stay there for 2 days minimum
- Empty drawers in dressers and nightstands (we will be taking the drawers out and treating inside them)
- Take the sheets off the beds and wash and dry them on high heat the day of the service
- You will need to be out of the house for 4 hours on the first visit
- You will need to be out of the house for 3 hours on the second visit
- We will be using a combination of liquid spray, dust (diatomaceous earth), and a fogging agent

### CLEAN UP INSTRUCTIONS

- Clean up instructions
- When arriving home, if there is any smell remaining from the chemical, open the windows and turn on ceiling fans
- Allow mattresses to dry before re-making the beds
- There will most likely be a dusty residue. It is non-toxic. If it bothers you, feel free to clean it up
- After 2 days you can bring your clothes back inside. We recommend washing each bag of clothes as you bring them back into the home as bedbug's hitch rides in your clothing and may be an original source of the infestation

### FOR THE SECOND VISIT 2 WEEKS LATER

- Take the sheets off the beds and wash and dry them on high heat the day of the service
- You do not need to remove all clothes from the rooms

### EXPECTATIONS

- Unfortunately, you will most likely still get bit through the process of eradicating the bedbugs. However, you will notice you are bit significantly less as time goes on
- After the second service, the bites should stop completely
